Rusty's Coulee Marina is in the process of a facelift.

Palliser Park has taken over the operation of the campgrounds, marina and store.

You will see some new faces who will be more than happy to accommodate you in your stay in the Park.. The Marina Supervisor is Terry Rollie..

Docks and slips will be open by May 4th and anyone holding a slip from last year and has renewed it for this year will have it available to them.

- docking fees will remain the same at \$5.00/day or \$100.00/year.

The prices for the Marina are:

- boat slip \$480.00/year for boats under 20' and \$540.00/year for anything over 20'

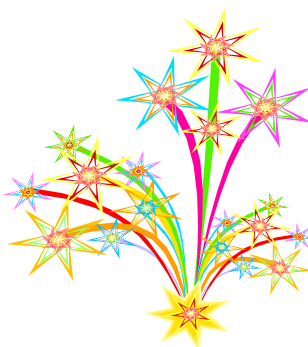
The 2009 Annual Notice to Consumers drinking water and compliance report will be posted at the office.

Be sure you are properly protected.

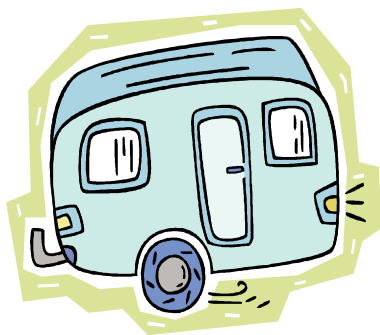
The DLCD Board is taking steps to provide quick early response in case of fire within Palliser Park.

TRAILER STORAGE



DLCD members should be aware that the **dry storage of ONE trailer/RV is permitted on your lease provided the trailer**

is owned and licensed by the lessee with its location subject to DLCD by-laws (located away from property lines and not creating a traffic hazard).

Temporary trailer/RV camping is permitted provided daily camping fees are paid to Palliser Regional Park.
